Dear Friends in Christ,



In honor of Catholic Charities' Month \$129,032 was collected.

To support the Back to School Fairs in DuPage and Will Counties, the Agency raised \$53,956.

Bears Care Foundation (Chicago Bears) awarded a \$35,000 grant for the Back to School Fair in Kankakee County.

The inaugural Tailgate for Hunger fundraiser took place in Joliet, raising \$12,561.

The Agency was awarded a \$3,700 grant from The Community Foundation of Will County to purchase a new Energy-Star industrial dishwasher used to support meals served daily to the homeless and hungry at Shepherd's Table at Daybreak Center in Joliet.

The Community Memorial Foundation awarded Catholic Charities Emergency Service and Homeless Prevention Program \$10,000.

The Agency was awarded \$18,000 through the Will County CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) Public Service Grant Program to fund a part-time bilingual intake coordinator position at Daybreak Center to meet the needs of clients whose first language is Spanish.

The Expectant Mothers Initiative welcomed the 400th baby in the program.

The 12th annual Undy Sunday took place with nearly 50 participating churches, schools, and other local organizations collecting underwear, socks, and diapers for distribution to those in need.



Playing for Miracles fundraiser was held at a new venue: The Carlisle in Lombard with a new theme – charitable gaming! This event raised \$108,905.

Ecolab, Inc. awarded the Agency \$5,000 for five Mobile Food Pantry distributions.

The Franciscan Foundation donated \$1,000 to help support Daybreak Center.

Held first rummage sale to benefit Catholic Charities.

Alexandria Early Childhood Center achieved accreditation by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). All five of our Head Start sites are NAEYC accredited.

Catholic Charities' Board of Young Professionals gathered for their first meeting.

The Blowitz-Ridgeway grant awarded Catholic Charities \$15,000 for the Back to School Fair events in Will and DuPage Counties.



2015 year in review

The Agency raised \$343,698 from the Christmas appeal.

The Dan Gibbons Turkey Trot Foundation donated \$25,000 from the proceeds of their annual Thanksgiving Day fun run to help fund Catholic Charities' services in DuPage County.



NASCAR Foundation (Chicagoland Speedway) awarded the Agency a \$8,222 grant to purchase age-appropriate fitness equipment for all five Head Start Centers to encourage physical activity.

The George M. Eisenberg Foundation for Charities awarded the Agency \$5,000 for the Permanent Supportive Housing Program.

The Exchange Club of Joliet awarded the Agency a \$1,000 grant for parenting classes and counseling for clients at Daybreak Center.

United Way of Grundy County awarded the Agency a \$2,500 mini-grant for counseling services in Grundy County.

The Walmart Foundation awarded Catholic Charities \$50,000 in funding for our Mobile Food Pantry Program, which provided 43 distributions throughout the seven counties the Agency serves.

The Angel Appeal raised \$197,807.

Holly Club of Joliet awarded the Agency \$1,000 for parenting classes for single mothers and counseling sessions for mothers and their children at Daybreak Center.

Fifth Third Bank donated \$5,000 to help fund the Money Management Program.

The United Way of Grundy County awarded the Agency \$15,000 in funding to support Community Services, Senior Companion Program, Counseling, and Adult Protective Services in Grundy County.

The Early Childhood Services Division of the Agency hosted a job fair in Joliet with over 50 participating employers.

The MAXIMUS Foundation awarded the Agency \$2,500 to fund parenting classes for single mothers at Daybreak Center and counseling for mothers and their children.

The Agency participated in First Look for Charity at the Chicago Auto Show and raised \$138,675.

The United Way of Kankakee and Iroquois Counties awarded the Agency \$63,500 to support ten programs in these counties.

The United Way of Will County awarded the Agency \$269,800 in support for the Back to School Fair; Mobile Food Pantries; Emergency Services; Daybreak Center; and Shepherd's Table in Will County.



The Agency participated in The Human Race, a fun walk/run hosted by Giving DuPage and raised \$1,805. Catholic Charities had the most participants of any of the 50+ participating local charities.

The DuPage Foundation awarded Catholic Charities \$20,000 in grant funding to provide emergency assistance and case management services for low-income individuals and families in DuPage County who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.



The Agency's Disaster Relief Team assisted storm/tornado victims in areas including Coal City and Braidwood.

The Joliet Junior Women's Club awarded the Agency a \$1,000 grant to provide counseling for women and children at Daybreak Center.

Community Services

Alternative Housing Programs

*DuPage, Ford, Grundy, Iroquois, Kankakee,
Kendall & Will Counties*

Providing a variety of housing programs for individuals and families who are homeless or at-risk, including transitional housing, permanent supportive housing and more. These programs are designed to maximize a family's self-sufficiency.

Hope House

DuPage County

Providing housing and supportive services to individuals and families who are homeless often due to divorce, job loss or depleted savings. During a temporary, short stay, participants work toward securing employment and permanent housing. Hope House also provides the only 24-hour crisis hotline to assist in the single point of entry process for the homeless services continuum in DuPage County.

Emergency Services & Homelessness Prevention

*Will, Grundy, Kendall, DuPage, Kankakee,
Ford & Iroquois Counties*

Providing food and travel vouchers; clothing and furniture vouchers; financial assistance for prescriptions; rent/mortgage assistance, and information/referral to other community resources.

Supportive Services for Veteran Families

*DuPage, Grundy, Iroquois, Kankakee, Kendall &
Will Counties*

Assisting veterans who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Available services include case management; employment and education assistance; locating housing, and helping pay rent arrearages or security deposits. Each program participant is linked with the US Department of Veteran Affairs to gauge eligibility for additional VA benefits and services.

Daybreak Center

Will, Grundy & Kendall Counties

Shelter Providing year-round emergency shelter 24 hours a day. The program also provides professional case management and wraparound services such as employment programs that promote self-sufficiency.

Shepherd's Table Feeding all members of the community who are hungry and unable to provide for themselves by offering a free mid-day meal. Shepherd's Table is also used as a warming and cooling center during extreme weather.



Matthew, 34, is known for his big smile and gentle spirit. He makes friends easily and is always generous with those he cares about. Unfortunately, by the time Matthew arrived at **Catholic Charities' Daybreak Center**, he had been struggling through a very difficult period of his life and was living on the streets.

With a diagnosis of paranoid schizophrenia, Matthew's life presents many challenges. During his 20s, Matthew had a fiancé, and the couple had four children together. However, as the years passed, Matthew's mental health struggles started interfering with his daily life. By the time he became homeless, Matthew had lost touch with his family and had legal troubles.

It was clear to the staff at the Daybreak Center that Matthew's mental health needed to be professionally addressed in order to keep him safe. They connected him with services through the Will County Health Department as they witnessed his situation deteriorating. As a result, Matthew was placed on medication that has helped stabilize him.

After Matthew's health improved, staff at the Daybreak Center determined that he would be a good candidate for their New Beginnings permanent supportive housing program. New Beginnings is located within Daybreak Center and provides a safe living environment for chronically homeless and disabled men.

Matthew was eager to take part in this program and smiles describing his new living space, "It's the biggest room!" He's working hard to maintain his good mental health and continues on a path for self-improvement, including learning how to budget his money effectively. In the meantime, he's doing very well. "I'm in a much better place," he said.

Counseling Services

Counseling Services

Will, Grundy, Kendall, DuPage, Kankakee, Ford & Iroquois Counties

Providing healing and hope through caring and effective behavioral health services. The diverse and professional therapists provide a wide range of therapeutic services including individual, group, family, and couples therapy, in addition to specialized services such as anger management groups and preventative education programs. Individuals and families who are struggling financially may qualify for services at a reduced fee. Most insurance is accepted, including Medicare Part B and Medicaid.



Deborah is a warm and friendly woman who has always enjoyed gardening, reading, and spending time with her friends and

family. She had a successful career in non-profit administration and project management. Two years ago, Deborah's life changed dramatically. A variety of health problems, including fibromyalgia and post-traumatic stress disorder, forced her to resign from her fulfilling career. Unable to fully support or care for herself, she moved from her own apartment into a home with her brother and his family. Deborah started to spend more time in bed. The loss of her job and independence created "a lost sense of self-worth and identity," she remembers.

Having experienced major depression in the past, Deborah recognized that she was feeling those same symptoms again. She knew that she needed to find help... fast.

Deborah learned that Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet provided **Counseling Services** and began seeing a therapist weekly. Through hard work, she has made tremendous progress. "Things are looking better in a lot of ways," she says. Deborah is learning to identify herself based on who she is and not what she does. Although it can be difficult to reach out and accept help during challenging times, Deborah suggests looking at it from this perspective: "A therapist is a part of your support team – like a doctor or a dentist. It's another tool in your toolbox."



Isabella is a sweet and strong little girl who is in her second year in Catholic Charities' **Head Start** program. Things aren't easy for Isabella's family. The young child has been diagnosed with an intellectual disability and has limited mobility. Throughout the challenges

this young family has faced, Isabella's mother always celebrates each accomplishment with her daughter. The family, who lives on a low-income, resides in public housing that is scheduled to be demolished, which adds to their stress. Isabella's mother does not know how to drive and relies on public transportation, but that never stops her from taking great care of Isabella and ensuring that she attends school each day. The young mother is grateful for the help and excellent education her daughter is receiving from Head Start. Despite her many challenges, she demonstrates strength, courage and unconditional love for not only her child, but for the life she has been given. She works on Isabella's I.E.P. (individualized education program) goals daily and takes her daughter's education and success very seriously. With the help of Head Start and strong family support, the future is bright for little Isabella!

Early Childhood Services

Will County

These programs include Head Start, Early Head Start, wraparound child care, Home-Based, and Expectant Mothers Initiative. Children participate in developmentally appropriate activities; receive medical and dental care; enjoy healthy meals and snacks, and appreciate playing indoors and outdoors in a safe center-based setting. Home-Based provides weekly home visits with an age appropriate educational focus for parent and child. Children with disabilities and differing abilities are encouraged to participate in an inclusive setting. Expectant mothers receive prenatal and post-partum education and assistance in preparing their home for their baby's arrival. Counseling and other mental health services are provided as needed to children and families. Family engagement is encouraged and supported. Family advocates work directly with families to provide supportive services such as financial planning and goal setting and assist in securing resources for job searches for employment, continued education, and ESL or GED in order for families to become self-sufficient.

Aging & Disability Services

Senior Companion Program

Will, Grundy, Kankakee & Iroquois Counties

Offering adults age 55 and older the opportunity to support and interact with their homebound, frail peers through regularly scheduled home visits.

Care Coordination

Kankakee County

Offering frail, older adults and their families assistance as they assess the need for care and coordinate an overall plan of service to maximize the older person's independence in the home.

Adult Protective Services

Kankakee & Grundy Counties

Providing trained and caring professionals to help determine the services most needed to stop neglect and abuse; protect the person who has suffered abuse and/or neglect; and assist the individual in the healing process. Intervention for the abuser is also offered.

Foster Grandparent Program

Will County

Offering adults age 55 and older an opportunity to work with children at local elementary schools and pre-schools.

Information and Assistance

Kankakee County

Providing information about and linkage to the many services and benefits available to older adults and persons with disabilities.

Money Management Program

Kankakee, Grundy, Iroquois & Will Counties

Offering adults the opportunity to serve and advocate for low-income older adults who have difficulty budgeting, paying routine bills and keeping track of financial matters.



After a long career in the medical and child care fields, an illness left Frances unable to work. This energetic and friendly woman couldn't imagine a future that didn't include caring for others. She started feeling depressed.

"I couldn't find a reason to get out of bed in the morning," Frances said. "I thought 'what am I going to do with myself?' " Frances's mother, who was involved in the **Foster Grandparent Program** for many years, suggested that she look into volunteering with the program.

Frances called Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet, and learned more about the program. The Foster Grandparent Program provides adults (ages 55 and older) the opportunity to work with children at local elementary schools and pre-schools. Foster grandparent volunteers receive a modest tax-free stipend and mileage reimbursement. They generally volunteer around 20 hours each week. This seemed like a perfect fit for Frances.

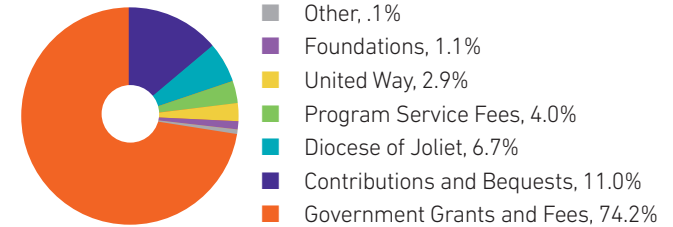
Frances was placed at Catholic Charities' Good Shepherd Head Start Center where she works with children up to five years old from low-income households. Each morning, when Frances arrives at Good Shepherd, the students run to her and enthusiastically welcome her. These warm greetings have become Frances's favorite part of the day. The children call her "Grandma Frances," and they adore her.

Frances adores the children and teachers at Good Shepherd and feels grateful for what the Foster Grandparent Program has added to her life. "Now I have a reason to wake up in the morning," she said. "Two years ago, I would have just laid in bed. Now, I'm inspired each day. This program was a lifesaver for me."

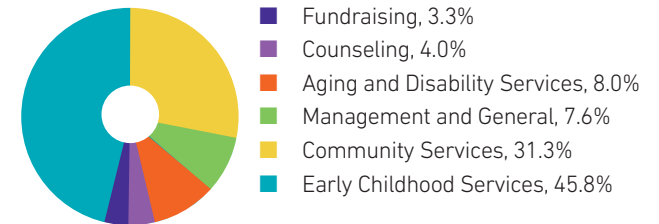

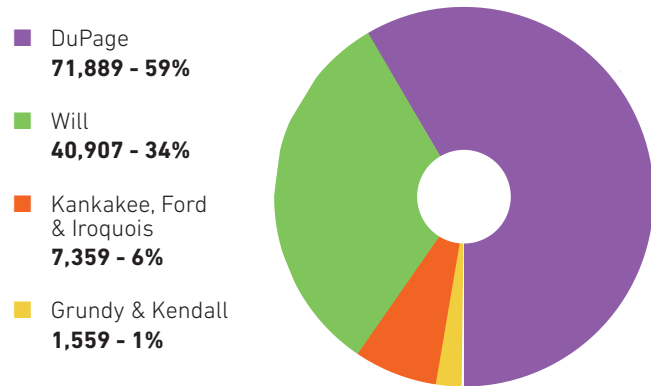

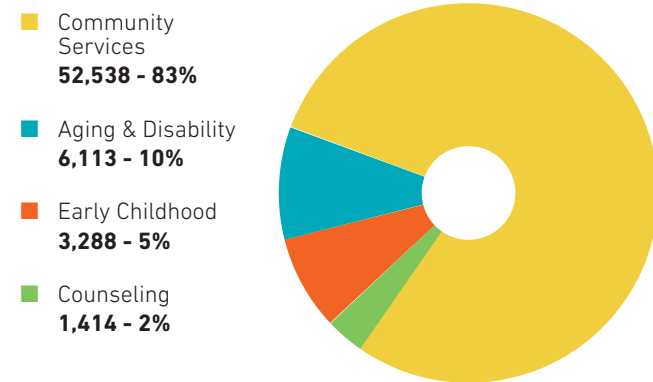
Housing & Emergency Shelter

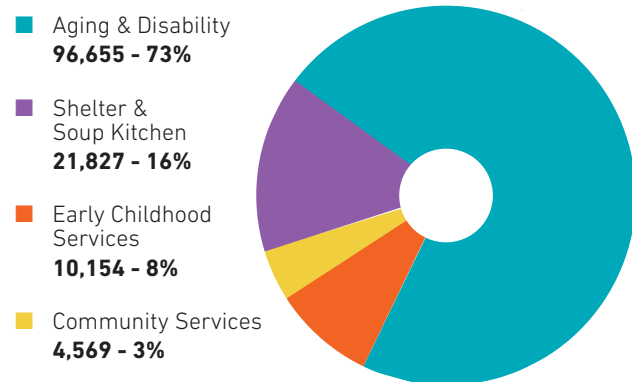

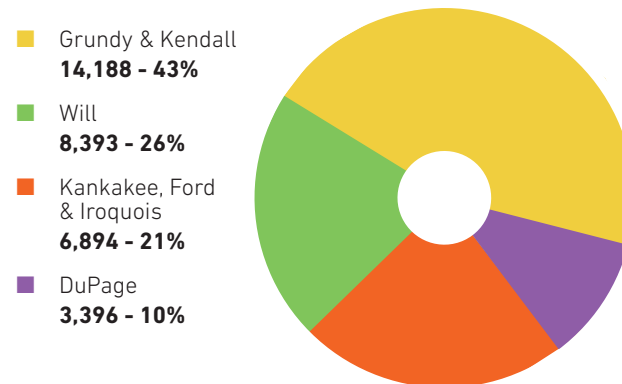
