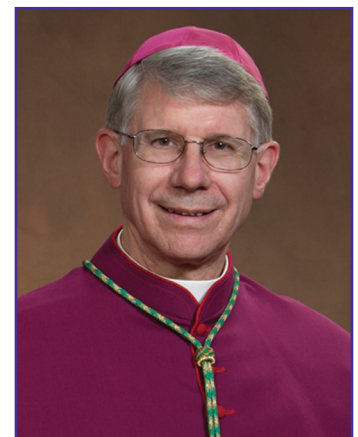
I offer my prayers and support to our brothers and sisters, regardless of immigration status, as each is a child of God.

Bears Care \$43,000 to support the Kankakee and Iroquois County Back to School Fair.

DuPage Foundation awarded \$20,000 to Catholic Charities to support Community Services.

Hope Floats, a cruise on the Fox River hosted by Catholic Charities Board of Young Professionals, raised \$10,289 for the Agency.

United Way of Grundy County awarded the Agency \$10,000 to support Counseling, Aging & Disability Services, and Community Services in Grundy County.

\$65,319 was collected in honor of Catholic Charities' Month (August).

\$43,324 was raised to support the Back to School Fairs in DuPage and Will Counties.

Playing for Miracles, the Agency's annual fundraising gala, raised \$167,143.

The All Souls' Appeal raised \$33,228 in memory of loved ones.

The United Way of Will County awarded the Agency \$216,800 in support of the Will County Back to School Fair, Foster Grandparent Program, Emergency Services, Homeless Prevention Services, Mobile Food Pantry Program, Emergency Shelter, Shepherd's Table, and the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program.

# year in review

The Blowitz-Ridgeway Foundation awarded \$10,000 to support Catholic Charities' housing programs in DuPage County.



The Agency was among 18 charities benefiting from First Look for Charity, the black-tie fundraiser at the Chicago Auto Show, which raised \$122,771.

The Agency raised \$299,280 from the Christmas Appeal.



The Dan Gibbons Turkey Trot Foundation donated \$25,000 from the proceeds of their annual Thanksgiving Day fun run in Elmhurst to help fund services in DuPage County.

The Frank J. Lewis Foundation awarded \$10,000 to Catholic Charities' Daybreak Center.

DuPage Medical Group awarded \$20,000 to Catholic Charities' Daybreak Center.

The Raskob Foundation for Catholic Activities awarded a \$20,000 matching grant to support Catholic Charities' Daybreak Center.



The Agency participated in The Human Race, a fun walk/run hosted by Giving DuPage and raised \$7,860.

United Way of Kankakee/Iroquois Counties awarded \$27,562 for Community Services, Counseling, and Aging & Disability Services in those counties.



Hope House, the Agency's homeless shelter in DuPage County, was dedicated in the loving memory of Kathy Paulsen.

The staff of J.C. Restoration, Inc. dedicated an entire day to cleaning and restoring nine of the Agency's facilities.

The Angel Fund raised \$250,282 with the generous help of an anonymous donor who matched the first \$50,000 in donations.

## Community Services

### Alternative Housing Programs

*DuPage, Ford, Grundy, Iroquois, Kankakee, Kendall & Will Counties*

Providing a variety of housing programs for individuals and families who are homeless or at-risk, including transitional housing, permanent supportive housing, and more. These programs are designed to help families build self-sufficiency.

### Kathy Paulsen Hope House

*DuPage County*

Providing housing and supportive services to individuals and families who are homeless often due to divorce, job loss or depleted savings. During a temporary, short stay, participants work toward securing employment and permanent housing. The Kathy Paulsen Hope House also provides the only 24-hour crisis hotline to assist in the single point of entry process for the homeless services continuum in DuPage County.

### Emergency Services & Homelessness Prevention

*Will, Grundy, Kendall & DuPage Counties*

Providing food; clothing; furniture and transportation vouchers; financial assistance for prescriptions; rent/mortgage assistance; and information/referral to other community resources.

### Supportive Services for Veteran Families

*DuPage, Grundy, Iroquois, Kankakee, Kendall & Will Counties*

Assisting veterans who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Available services include case management, employment and education assistance, locating housing, and helping pay rent arrearages or security deposits. Each program participant is linked with the US Department of Veterans Affairs to gauge eligibility for additional VA benefits and services.

### Daybreak Center

*Will, Grundy & Kendall Counties*

#### Shelter

Providing year-round emergency shelter 24 hours a day. The program also provides professional case management and wraparound services, such as employment programs, that promote self-sufficiency.

#### Shepherd's Table

Feeding all members of the community who are hungry and unable to provide for themselves by offering a free mid-day meal. Shepherd's Table is also used as a warming and cooling center during extreme weather.



**Evelyn** is a client in Catholic Charities' Permanent Supportive Housing Program.

*Before I entered Catholic Charities' Permanent Supportive Housing Program I was lost and without hope. I had been in a domestic violence relationship for over ten years. I lost all self-confidence and I lost who I was as a person. When I got a call stating that I had been approved for housing, I was beyond excited.*

*Being in the program my Catholic Charities case manager has helped me to figure out who I am and what I want to do with myself. We work on being organized - I have four kids so my hands are pretty full. Now I have a stable home and I'm in school. I would have never thought I would have a chance at working toward getting my bachelors degree in human services. Catholic Charities has given me hope and a sense of direction. I thank them for choosing me.*

## Counseling

### Counseling Services

*Will, Grundy, Kendall, DuPage, Kankakee, Ford & Iroquois Counties*

Providing healing and hope through caring and effective behavioral health services. The diverse and professional therapists provide a wide range of therapeutic services, including individual, group, family, and couples therapy, in addition to specialized services such as anger management groups and preventative education programs. Individuals and families who are struggling financially may qualify for services at a reduced fee. Most insurance is accepted, including Medicare Part B and Medicaid.

**Jack\*** is a client in Catholic Charities' Counseling Program.

*It takes courage to reach out for help, but when Jack was lonely and overwhelmed by his life, he sought help from Catholic Charities' Counseling Program and was warmly welcomed. Over the past few years, Jack has experienced many hardships, which motivated him to connect with a Catholic Charities' counselor. He began working to manage untreated mental health issues, which had contributed to his recent challenges. Jack also is learning to cope with a variety of other stressful circumstances. He works two jobs in order to support himself, his son, and his elderly parents who face chronic illnesses. An active member of his community, Jack also volunteers at his church. Despite outwardly appearing to have everything pulled together, Jack has expressed in counseling that he struggles to keep his "head above water." Counseling is a very important element in Jack's life to talk about his challenges and to learn to cope with them. Today, he's prioritizing self-care whenever he can and has been reconnecting with some of his favorite hobbies, including gardening, cooking, and following professional sports. Despite often feeling stressed and overwhelmed, Jack continues to have faith that his positive choices will pay off in the long run for his family.*

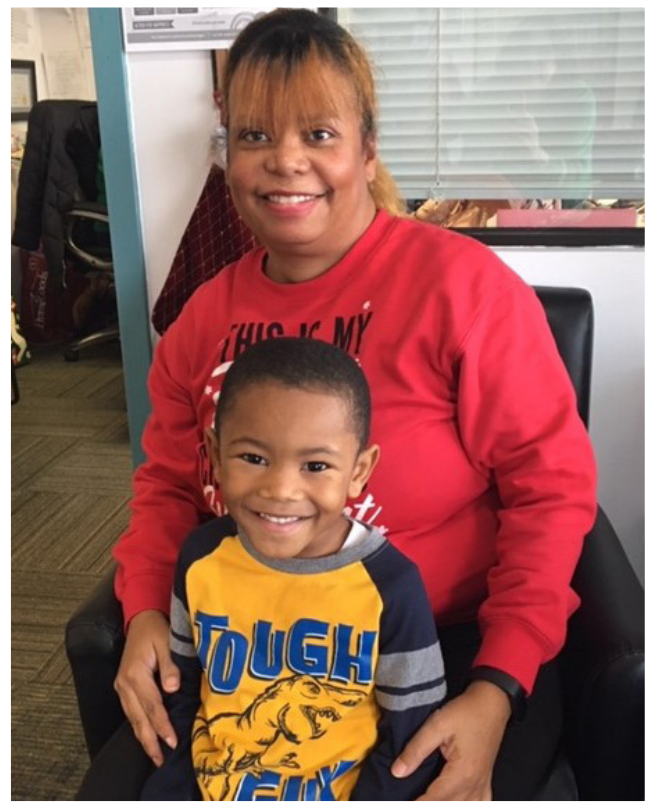


## Early Childhood Services

### Early Childhood Services

#### Will County

These programs include Head Start, Early Head Start, Home-Based programs, Expectant Mothers Initiative, and wraparound childcare services. Children participate in developmentally appropriate activities, receive medical and dental care, enjoy healthy meals and snacks, and appreciate playing indoors and outdoors in a safe, center-based setting. Home-Based Programs provides weekly home visits with an age appropriate educational focus for parent and child. Children with disabilities and differing abilities are encouraged to participate in an inclusive setting. Expectant mothers receive prenatal and post-partum education and assistance in preparing the home for baby's arrival. Counseling and other mental health services are provided as needed to children and families. Family engagement is encouraged and supported. Family advocates work directly with families to provide supportive services, such as financial planning and goal setting, and assist in securing resources for job searches, continued education, and ESL or GED to help families become self-sufficient.



**Noah** is a client in Catholic Charities' Head Start Program.

## Aging & Disability Services

### Senior Companion Program

*Will, Grundy, Kankakee & Iroquois Counties*

Offering adults age 55 and older the opportunity to support and interact with homebound peers through regularly scheduled home visits.

### Care Coordination

*Kankakee County*

Offering frail, older adults and families assistance in assessing the need for care and coordinating an overall plan of service to maximize the older person's independence in the home.

### Adult Protective Services

*Kankakee & Grundy Counties*

Providing trained and caring professionals to help determine the services most needed to stop neglect and abuse, protect the person who has suffered abuse or neglect, and assist the individual in the healing process. Intervention for the abuser is also offered.

### Foster Grandparent Program

*Will County*

Offering adults age 55 and older an opportunity to work with children at local elementary schools and pre-schools.

### Information and Assistance

*Kankakee County*

Providing information about, and linkage to, the many services and benefits available to older adults and persons with disabilities.

### Money Management Program

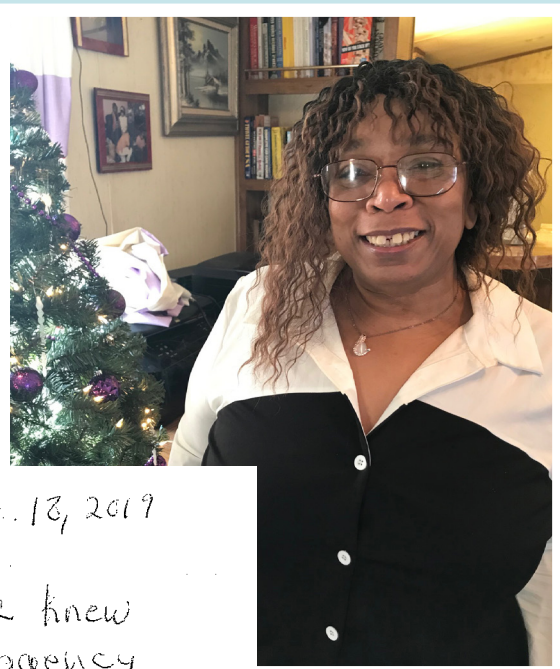
*Kankakee, Grundy, Iroquois & Will Counties*

Offering adults the opportunity to serve and advocate for low-income older adults who have difficulty budgeting, paying routine bills, and keeping track of financial matters.

### Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program

*Grundy, Kankakee, & Will Counties*

Volunteers provide advocacy and support for residents in long-term care facilities, acting at the direction of the resident to resolve his/her concerns or complaints.

I am not Catholic therefore I never knew exactly what the Catholic Charities agency helped with. After driving a school bus for years while raising my nephew, I found myself disabled physically, mentally and financially. Living on a second floor apartment and having degenerative knee problems I was even suicidal. After a fall on the stairs leading up to my apartment someone called Catholic Charities and it was like throwing me a life raft. Two workers came out and assessed my situation and quickly implemented a series of actions that I can truly say saved my life. They helped me move into a senior building, paid the deposit, referred me to legal services I got my nephew (who I had sent to live with my daughter) back home with me. Catholic Charities even helped get the two of us a refrigerator and bed after I found a place big enough for us both.

The relatives raising children's program has provided me with so much support. I can now see a light at the end of the tunnel. I even feel encouraged to adopt the child I have raised since he was four.

# Welcoming the Stranger to Restore Their Dignity

I arrived at the Basilica of Our Lady of San Juan del Valle, in San Juan, Texas, in mid-July at 6:30 p.m. It was a scorching 107 degrees. The hotel lobby was filled to the brim with migrant families. Children played, read books, or clung to their parent's hips, burying their heads, too afraid to even look up.

I was in Texas because of President's Trump's "zero tolerance" policy regarding illegal immigration, which

led to nearly 2,000 undocumented immigrant children being held in government custody and separated from their parents. When the federal government was under pressure to meet a court-ordered July 26 deadline to reunite these families, Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley was told to prepare to receive more than 400 families. Because migrant families would be arriving each day and throughout the night, the agency knew that its center needed to stay open 24 hours.

With only a staff of six – and knowing the needs of these traumatized families would be great – Sister Norma Pimentel, executive director of Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Rio Grande Valley, sent out an emergency cry for help throughout the Catholic Charities network (CC-USA) seeking additional volunteers to help with the crisis at the border.

As I stood at the door, I tried to make sense of what I saw. Boxes and boxes of clothing and toiletries were stacked against the wall, and lines of families waited behind them. Children reacted like it was Christmas morning as they tried on new shoes and held up new t-shirts or shorts to see if they would fit.

Volunteers passed out fresh mangos and bottles of water to the families as they waited. Then I saw four long

banquet tables with a line that stretched out the door. Case managers were seated at the tables performing intakes one family at a time. There was not a printer, copier or fax machine in sight. Instead, case managers painstakingly handprinted pages and pages of documentation for each individual. I heard volunteers shouting bus departure times in a language I recognized but did not understand. Volunteers waited nearby to drive families to the bus station or to the airport. One volunteer attempted to have families who were not yet assigned a bedroom form a line. I looked out the window as a roaring bus pulled up and at least another 100 people exited their seats and headed toward the lobby door.

Then I looked up to see a very pregnant young woman in front of me holding two children in her arms. Tears filled her eyes and an ankle monitor clung to her ankle. I froze. Instantly I felt overwhelmed and despondent. I had traveled from Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet, as a communications expert to help with the crisis at the border, yet I had absolutely no idea what I was in store for or how I could begin to make a difference with the madness in front of me. I don't even speak Spanish.

As I stood there, two families approached me, frantically speaking in a language I did not understand. I immediately felt helpless. I could not imagine how I could even make a dent in the catastrophe I was witnessing. I hastened a bi-lingual volunteer to assist these families, then I made my way through the crowded lobby and into my room.

I caught my breath, dried my tears, said a quick "Our Father," then threw on my Catholic Charities t-shirt, a pair of capris and gym shoes and made my way back to the lobby. I found a group of volunteers from Catholic Charities, Diocese of Dallas. Avril Knox, a brilliant team leader, led me around, making sure I was familiar with the campus. I was aghast when we arrived at the auditorium and saw even more migrant families gathered. Sleeping mats and blankets were piled to the ceiling and more volunteers processed intake forms and change of venue forms for the court. Volunteers were making phone calls to family members who already resided in the U.S., hoping to find a sponsor for their family who would purchase bus tickets or airfare and provide a temporary residence within the United States.

Families huddled together as I made my way past the auditorium and toward the first of three warehouses



where in-kind donations were stored. Six volunteers tried to keep supplies and donations organized as FedEx and UPS trucks arrived hourly. Families and corporations throughout the country were shipping boxes of donations to the warehouse to help support these migrant families. People drove across the country to hand-deliver items they thought could be used. By week's end however, this small group of volunteers who had worked so diligently to keep some sort of order simply gave up when there was barely any floor space left because donations covered the entire space, ceiling to floor.

The next day was one of my hardest days in Texas as a flu virus began to spread. We rushed to gather Pepto-Bismol and Imodium from the local Walmart. Pedialyte and Tylenol were in high demand and were given to all the families in need. Babies and their parents were miserable. They were hot, dehydrated and just coming to terms with the trauma they had endured.

We continued comforting families, making sure they were taking in proper nourishment and were getting the rest and medication they needed. The families were exhausted and running only on adrenaline. We sanitized mattress pads and bleached the floors. We tended to the sick families while new families were arriving, and others were leaving. With new families came new challenges. Lice impacted many families sleeping in confined spaces. However, nothing slowed down the volunteers, nor the gratitude of those we were serving. Catholic Charities volunteers met each crisis with a solution, and we witnessed the deepest appreciation from the most loving people I have ever served.

Our work continued throughout the night as we awoke to welcome new families arriving and transport families leaving for the bus station. Many families had days of travel ahead of them. We prepared large manila envelopes with their documentation and itineraries inside. We wrote in thick magic marker on the outer envelope, "I AM TRAVELING. I DO NOT SPEAK ENGLISH. CAN YOU HELP ME?" I prayed that God would keep only good and loving people in these families' paths. Sometimes families were turned away at the bus station or airport when a relative's credit card failed or when a ticket was cancelled. After coming so far, families were devastated to return to the respite center only to wait and try again the next day. Emotions ran at a constant high, something both volunteers and families experienced alike.

The relentless stress, tension and fear were something I had never experienced before.

Before families moved on, parents wanted to tell their stories. They wanted to be heard. Many wanted me to know what it was like to have been separated from their children, not knowing where their children were or if they would ever see them again. The anguish and fear were, at times, too much to bear. Although I had not personally experienced their grief or despair, I still felt broken. I would listen to heart-wrenching stories through a translator. Then I would throw my arms around the parents and their children and cry with them. Then families with whom I had worked for days would leave. I would sing, dance and shout hooray as they left, knowing secretly how sad I was that they were leaving and how worried I was for what lay ahead on their journey.

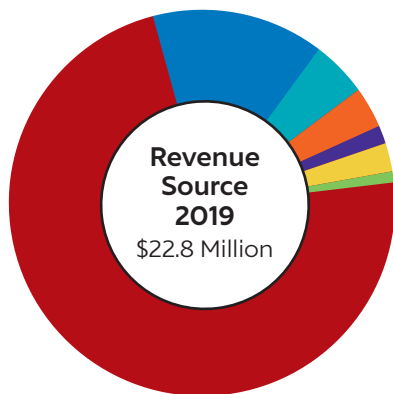
In my days at the Rio Grande Valley, I processed intakes; filled out thousands of forms; nursed the sick; disinfected the common spaces; purchased medication; prepared food; distributed meals; distributed toiletries and clothing; ran to and from the bus station, airport, and respite center; organized donations; and even helped rid head lice. But what I will remember the most are the times I cried with our families, laughed with our families, sang and danced with the children and hugged our families farewell.

My experiences with these beautiful families have changed my life forever. I quickly discovered that the language of love, compassion, and decency was all I needed to know to be understood and to understand. I learned that, despite all the turmoil in this country, people are good and caring and that each of us can make a difference, no matter how small.

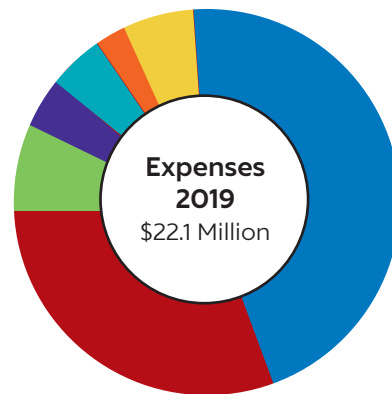
I was never more proud to represent Catholic Charities, the ministry I believe I have been called to serve. As I flew home, I recalled my favorite passage from Matthew 25:35 which states, "For I was hungry, and you gave me food. I was thirsty and you gave me drink. I was a stranger, and you welcomed me." What an honor and privilege it was for me to be able serve these beautiful families whom I will forever hold close to my heart and feel deeply on my soul.

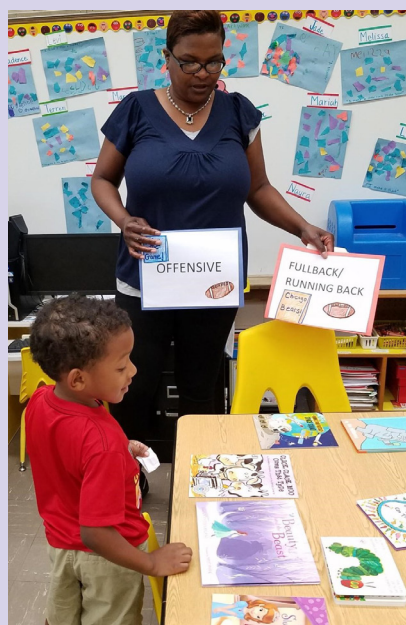
