Shepherd's Table (Joliet)

- Cook and serve meals at Daybreak Center. Food and recipes are provided or cook at home and bring the meals to the shelter to serve.
- Thursday food prep for pre-packaged meals.
- Sort and organize food.
- Pick up food from various locations and deliver to Daybreak Center. Pickups may be on short notice.

Daybreak Center (Joliet)

- Clean the facility.
- Organize a collection drive for housewares, personal care items, or cleaning supplies. Please contact us for specific needs.
- Gardening/landscaping.
- Sorting/organizing donation items.

Emergency Services (Joliet)

- Assist with general office work (filing, data entry).
- Pick up and deliver donations.
- Transport furniture (either using own truck or as a member of a moving team) from donor's homes to client's apartments.

Holiday Outreach (Joliet)

- Organize and sort holiday donations.

Back to School Fair (Joliet, Plainfield)

- Fill resource bags.

Fundraisers (Various locations)

- Gather donation items for raffles/silent auctions.

Head Start (Joliet, Bolingbrook)

- Secure groups to read with students, perform clerical duties, help with crafts, and create parties for children around holidays.
